<u>VARIETY NAME</u>	<u>BLOOM TIME*</u>	<u>HARVEST TIME</u>	<u>KEEPING ABILITY</u>	<u>USES</u>	<u>COMMENTS</u>
Honeycrisp Dwarf	mid	mid September	long	1,2,3	extremely crisp; juicy; sweet flavor
Haralred Dwarf	late	early September	long	5	redder than Haralson; tart, but slightly sweeter than Haralson; resistant to russetting and fireblight
Haralson Dwarf	late	late September	long	5	crisp; juicy; hardy; fireblight resistant; natural semi-dwarf
Zestar!	early	mid to late August	medium	1,2	crisp; juicy; sweet tart
Snowsweet	late	September		5	newer variety; extremely hardy, fruit is sweet and tart; white flesh; large, juicy fruits

USE KEY:

1 - eating 2 - baking/pies 3 - sauce 4 - salad 5 - all uses

*Planting varieties that bloom at about the same time helps to improve cross-pollination.
